**Leonard Cheshire** – Bishop Alan celebrated a Requiem Mass for Leonard Cheshire on Thursday last, being the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of his birth, thus opening the Diocese's promotion of his Cause, aiming at his Beatification. Leonard Cheshire was a noted hero of World War 2, earning the VC amongst many other medals. Subsequently he became a Catholic, and devoted the rest of his life to Christ, first through caring for sick and disabled people in his worldwide organization now known as **Leonard Cheshire Disability**. And more specifically in offering two periods of severe disability to the Lord: first TB, causing his being bedridden for two years, during which he focused in prayer on the Holy Face of Jesus as seen on the shroud of Turin; and secondly through suffering uncomplainingly from Motor Neurone disease, from which he died on 31<sup>st</sup> July 1992. He lived in our Diocese, and is buried in Cavendish in Suffolk. **Prayer cards asking for his intercession are available at the back of the Cathedral.**
