## Catechesis Corner

Catholicism is a missionary faith, because it wants to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with everyone. We do not keep our faith to ourselves; we do not keep it private. When a person is baptised into the Church, they are given a lighted candle that symbolises Christ the Light of the World. As Catholics we are bound to share this Light with the whole world, just as Jesus asked His first disciples to proclaim Him in every nation. We call this *evangelisation*, which comes from the Greek word *Evangelion*, meaning Good News. We evangelise through showing charity to others and practicing a life of virtue, a life which attracts people and makes them wonder what and who is the source of that life.
