Holyday of Obligation – Starting this year the Bishops of England & Wales have reinstated the Feast of the Ascension on its traditional day (the Thursday 9 days before Pentecost, rather than on the Sunday). This means that we are obliged as Catholics to go to Mass this Thursday or the evening before, as we would do on a normal Sunday.
