SOLEMNITY OF ST JOHN THE BAPTIST SUNDAY 24TH JUNE

Our Patronal Festival is celebrated today and the Bishop will celebrate the 11.00 Mass.

Tuesday 26th June is the Feast of Dedication when the Cathedral was consecrated. Mass at the usual times of 11.00am and 7.00pm, and the Cathedral Chapter will celebrate Mass at 12.00 noon and Sung Vespers at 4.00pm. Please note **no Vespers** at 6.30pm.
