On Friday, 20th July, Deacon Andrew Eburne will be ordained to the Priesthood by Bishop Alan in the Cathedral at 7.00pm.

New Additions to The Cathedral – The Go-Go Hare in the Rotunda is painted with the stained glass figures from the Cathedral windows.

A Very Special Figure of St John the Baptist is in the cabinet at the back of the Cathedral it is from the Bow factory and dates from 1750. It is a unique piece and has been donated to the Cathedral by a friend.

Shrine of Our Lady – a parishioner has given a beautiful statue of Our Lady and Child to be placed in the garden. The statue will be Blessed after the 11.00 Mass on Sunday 8th July.

First Holy Communion (FHC) and Confirmation Programmes 2018-19 are now open for registration. Children aged 7 and above (entering Yr 3 in September 2018) should apply for FHC. Students aged 13 and above (entering Yr 9 in Sep` 18) please apply for the Confirmation programme. Registration forms are available at the back of the Cathedral. Please return your form enclosing a copy of the baptism certificate to the marked brown box at the back of the cathedral as soon as possible and no later than 27 August 2018, to help us plan for the programme. Please help us spread the word about registrations and encourage family and friends to get those forms in as soon as possible.

As an outreach gesture the First Holy Communion families have brought in dry/tinned food or personal hygiene/cleaning items to be offered up during the First Holy Communion Masses. The food will be donated to the foodbank and other items will be packed into rucksacks and given to refugees and asylum seekers who arrive in Norwich with little of their own. If you would like to support this initiative items will be collected until Sunday 1st July. Place all donations in the collection box in the Rotunda.
