St Teresa of Jesus – October 15th

St. Teresa of Avila (1515-1582) joined the Carmelite Order at the age of 18 and chose Christ as her heavenly Spouse. With the help of St. John of the Cross she reformed many Carmelite convents and founded new ones. She taught her nuns to hear the voice of Christ within them, in what she called the 'Interior Castle'; and she reminded them that we are not truly alive until we live "the essence of our life" – which is Jesus Christ.. She thought a day was wasted if she hadn't started a new book! In 1970 Pope Paul VI named her the first female Doctor of the Church.

One of her most famous poems reads:
"Let nothing disturb you. Let nothing make you

afraid. All things are passing. God alone never changes. Patience gains all things. If you have God, you will want for nothing. God alone suffices."
