A very special occasion will take place on Wednesday 7th November at 1200 noon when we will welcome the Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, who will begin his visit to the Anglican Diocese of Norwich at St John's. There will be a short service at 12noon to mark this historic visit.

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

Next Sunday marks the 100th anniversary of the ending of WWI, and this will be a national day of thanksgiving. Norwich city will mark the Armistice at 11am, and Canon Paul will represent the Catholic community. There will be an Acr of Remembrance on behalf of the city at City Hall from 6.40pm to 7pm. At 7.05 all the city churches will ring their bells to mark the end of the war, and to pray for peace in our world.

"ARMISTICE : LEGACY OF THE GREAT WAR"- Exhibition @ Norwich Castle Museum to mark the ending of World War 1 in 1918, running until 6th Jan, 2019 : among the many interesting items on display the only religious object is a small 'Trench Art' brass cross made from a ship's propeller that has been loaned by the Cathedral. We are grateful to the county museum service for including St John's in the exhibition.
