Many of you will have contributed to the rucksacks in one way or another; so you may be interested in the following information: In the 12 months between January 2018 and January 2019 together we have provided 62 rucksacks (24 for men, 17 for women, 12 for children aged between 9 and 16, and 9 for small children). The majority have come from Iran, Iraq, Afghanistan, Sudan and Kuwait. We thank you on their behalf.
