First Holy Communions. Our children will be making their First Holy Communion at the following masses at 6 pm on Saturday 22nd June; 9 am & 11 am on Sunday 23rd June & 11 am Sunday 30th June. Please keep them & their families in our prayers as they prepare to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for the first time.

Corpus Christi Procession. There will be a Procession of the Blessed Sacrament after the 11am Mass on Corpus Christi, which will conclude with Benediction in the Garden.

Next week we celebrate two feasts especially associated with the Cathedral: the **Feast of St John the Baptist**, our parish patron saint, on **Monday 24th**, and the **Dedication of the Cathedral on Wednesday 26th**. There will be an additional evening Mass on both Monday 24th and Wednesday 26th.
