This Sunday is the Feast of Pentecost when we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit and the birth of the Church. 35 young people will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation at the 11am Mass, when they are anointed by the Bishop and receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Please pray for our young people as they receive this wonderful Sacrament, which strengthens them to witness to their faith and the faith of the Church.

First Holy Communions. Our children will be making their First Holy Communion at the following masses in June: 6 pm on Saturday 22nd June; 9 am and 11am on Sunday 23rd June; and 11 am on Sunday 30th June. Please keep them and their families in your prayers as they prepare to receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament for the first time.
