## Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On August 15<sup>th</sup> we celebrate the Assumption of Our Lady into heaven. This great feast reminds us that Jesus Christ has destroyed the power of death, and given us all the hope of eternal life in body and in soul. Our mother Mary has been granted a special place as Queen of Heaven, to intercede for us.

This is a Holy Day of Obligation, when we are all supposed to go to Mass:

There are four Mass times to choose from: Wednesday at 7pm (Vigil Mass); then Thursday at 7.30am, 10am and 7pm. Our Lady, Queen of Heaven – pray for us!

The statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the garden now has reservoirs set in the ground for flowers. Please do make your offering of flowers to Our Lady.
