## Changes to the Cathedral Schedule.

From September 7<sup>th</sup> there will no longer be Confessions on Saturday afternoon. Instead there will be Confessions immediately before the Saturday and the Sunday evening Mass. Do take advantage of this opportunity to encounter Christ in the Sacrament. If it has been a long time since you went to Confession, or if you are unsure about anything, do speak to one of the priests.

As we are now blessed with an additional priest, from September 9<sup>th</sup> there will be an additional Mass on every weekday: an early morning (7.30am) Mass on Monday, Wednesday and Friday; and an evening (7pm) Mass on Tuesday and Thursday. The 10am Mass will continue as normal every weekday.

We welcome to the parish this weekend Deacon Peter Wygnanski studying at the English College in Rome, who will be spending September at St. John's as part of his formation before ordination to the priesthood next July.

The statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the garden now has reservoirs set in the ground for flowers. Please do make your offering of flowers to Our Lady.
