Today is the solemnity of the **Presentation of the Lord**, when we commemorate the Infant Jesus presented in the Temple by his parents, as required by the Jewish Law. The feast is often called **Candlemas**, because of the prophet Simeon's calling Jesus the Light of the Nations. At all Masses candles will be blessed at the beginning of Mass, and at the solemn Mass, there will be a solemn entrance with the procession of light.

Anointing of the Sick Mass – to coincide with the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, a special Mass will be celebrated for the diocese on Saturday 8th February at 11.30 here in the Cathedral. There will be an opportunity for those who so wish to receive the Sacrament of the Sick – the laying on of hands, and the anointing with the oil of the sick. It is also an opportunity for all of us to pray for those who are ill in any way, and to ask the Lord to bless all in the medical profession who share his healing ministry.

Pilgrimage to the Holy Land – several people have made enquiry about the possibility of another pilgrimage to the Holy Land around November.
