#### A SPECIAL DATE FOR YOUR DIARY

On Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> July, Deacon Andrew Eburne will be ordained to the Priesthood by Bishop Alan in the Cathedral at 7.00pm.

For those who missed Fr Henry's Announcement at the end of last Sunday's Masses, he will be finishing here in the parish at the end of July in order to go discern a vocation as a Benedictine monk. He writes: "This is something I have been thinking and praying about for a few years, and the Bishop has given me his permission and blessing to take a year and discern it further, to see if it is God's will. The community is a recent foundation in Tasmania, Australia – not a place that initially came to mind (!), but there are reasons for deciding on that community that are too long to go into here. I would like to thank Fr Paul and the clergy of the house and everyone in the parish for their welcome since I have been here, and to say it's been a joy to serve you as a priest, and to get to know so many of you (especially recently with the great take up on Easter House Blessings!). I will be praying for you when I go, and ask for your prayers for my discernment. Meanwhile, I look forward to making the most of my last two months with you"

Fr Paul Madison, Parish Priest of March and a former administrator of the Cathedral will also be leaving the Diocese to test his vocation in the Benedictine Monastery at Douai. Please pray for both Fr Henry and Fr Paul at this important time of discernment.
