Civil regulations allow Churches to remain open for communal worship. All our times remain as normal.

We strongly encourage you to come to Mass on a day other than Sunday if you are able to do so. Not attending Mass on Sundays at this time does not carry the weight of sin. We should still remember to pray at home on Sundays if we don't come to Mass.

Please call us if you need to, or if you know someone who does need a priest. We may not know that you need a priest or are sick unless we are told.

Bishop Alan has asked all parishes to pray for the election of a new bishop of East Anglia, after he submitted his resignation at the age of 75 last year. Sometimes, the process of replacing a bishop takes quite a long time, and it all remains a mystery *even* to the Cathedral clergy. Prayer cards are available, a weekly Mass will be celebrated for this intention, and a prayer will be said after other daily 10am Masses. Bishop Alan remains our bishop until his successor is announced.

The 3pm Sunday Holy Qurbana has now moved permanently from St John's to Holy Apostles, so that it doesn't have to move around week-by-week.

Mass intentions – to get a specific date, you may wish to plan a **long time in advance** to mark an occasion. Envelopes available at the back.

Building works - last month we were very pleased to have been awarded substantial sums of money from Historic England for the urgent works of repairing the north transept roof, replacing worn out electrics, and replacement of stolen lead gutters. The amount awarded to us was £317,000 - the largest grant given to any Catholic Cathedral or Church in the country. In order to secure the grant, work must be finished by the end of March, so you will see contractors are already busy on the roof. A condition of the grant was that 20% should be raised by the Cathedral which would amount to **£78,000**, necessitating a large loan from the diocese. However, in an act of amazing generosity, an anonymous benefactor has offered to pay this amount for us. Furthermore, the same donor wishes to pay the entire cost of replacing the drainage system which did not attract any grants. This amounts to **£163,000** and we are **truly grateful for such generosity** to our beautiful Cathedral.



Thank you for you old copies of Magnificat. The prison volunteers now have plenty of copies for prisoners, and will need to pause the collection for a while. Thank you for your generosity.
