This Sunday, Bishop Alan celebrates his 18th anniversary as a bishop. He was ordained in 2003 by Cardinal Murphy-O'Connor in Westminster Cathedral. We continue to pray for a new bishop, Bishop Alan's successor, now that he has submitted his resignation upon retirement.

At the 11am Mass on Sunday, Bishop Alan will also bless the **restored statue of Our Lady of Sorrows** which sits beside the Lady Chapel in the north transept. The restoration has been sponsored very generously by Mr Peter Thorn in memory of his mother, Louisa Thorn. The statue has been restored lovingly and prayerfully by Jacek Kulikowski over a period of months. We thank Peter and Jacek for their offering and talents.
