The bishops of our country are starting to encourage us to look towards the post-pandemic future with Christian hope and love. They have published a reflection for us, considering especially the real need to slowly reintroduce our physical participation in the sacraments, to encourage a return to Church for those who have lapsed, and, eventually, to reintroduce the Sunday Obligation to attend Mass which has been suspended for over a year now. Please take a copy from the back of the Cathedral, and consider their words for ourselves and for others as our society begins to open up again.

Bishop Alan will lead the diocesan pilgrimage to Walsingham on Bank Holiday Monday 3rd May. We are able to participate physically only by booking online (walsingham.org.uk/product/diocese-of-east-anglia-pilgrimage/), or you can follow the pilgrimage by live stream on the shrine website (walsingham.org.uk). Mass will be at 12 noon; benediction at 2.30pm
