This week, from 18 January, the annual week of prayer for Christian unity begins. This initiative began 114 years ago, and, while not a formal liturgical octave, all the popes since Pope Pius X has encouraged Catholic participation in it. Christ intended that the Christian family be at unity with one another ("that they may all be one"), and it is a problem that the Church has been formally divided within itself for well over a thousand years. We pray most especially this week that this scandal is removed by God's good grace, by our humility and repentance, and by our common Christian lives of holiness. Every day in Mass, the Church prays for unity: "grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will."

On **Thursday 20 January**, we joyfully host an ecumenical chain of prayer in St Joseph's Chapel throughout the day from 10.30am until 4pm. **Our own parish "slot" will be at 10.30am**, immediately after the 10am Mass on Thursday, and **we are all warmly encouraged to attend** after Mass, but we are most welcome to attend some or many of the other prayers that will be said by our Christian brothers and sisters throughout the day in the Chapel.



Next Sunday (23 January), the Deputy Lieutenant for Norfolk, **Group Captain Stewart Blackburn**, will attend the 11am Solemn Mass on behalf of The Queen, and will thank our Catholic community for our prayers, good works, and pastoral care for our city during the pandemic.



Our annual four-week marriage preparation course starts on Thursday 20 January. All couples who are preparing for marriage this year attend this catechetical teaching course, where we will explore the Church's teaching about marriage. As well as couples preparing for marriage, this year we would also like to invite any other married couple to attend one or any of the classes, if you would like a catechetical refresher about what this sacrament means from the Church's perspective. This week, our first class is on **The Three Goods of Marriage**. Thursday 20 January, 7.30pm in the Cathedral Hall.
