This Sunday, the Deputy Lieutenant for Norfolk, **Group Captain Stewart Blackburn**, will attend the 11am Solemn Mass on behalf of The Queen, and will thank our Catholic community for our prayers, good works, and pastoral care for our city during the pandemic. **We warmly welcome him.**

We also continue to commemorate the **Week of Prayer for Christian Unity** this Sunday, which concludes on Tuesday with a Sung Mass, the feast of the **Conversion of S Paul.**



On **Monday this week**, **Bishop Alan** celebrates the 19th anniversary of his ordination as a bishop. It is a joy this year to be able to celebrate this with him at the 10am Parish Mass. We also welcome at Mass **Archbishop Bernard Longley**, the Archbishop of Birmingham, who was ordained alongside Bishop Alan in Westminster Cathedral.

Also from Monday this week (until Wednesday) there will be **major works on the window in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel.** On Monday, scaffolding will be erected behind the chapel altar, and on Tuesday and Wednesday, the craftsmen will carefully remove the window to be taken away for restoration. This means that for some sustained period of time on those days, **it will not be possible to reserve the Blessed Sacrament in the Cathedral building all the time while the manual work is taking place.** This is because we are unable to provide an adequately secure place for another tabernacle. The Cathedral Church will remain open all day each day, however.
