Cathedral Church open daily from 7.30am until 7pm

This Sunday is the feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. The Church commemorates in a special liturgical way the profound gift of himself in the Eucharist. The Eucharist truly is Jesus Christ, his Body, his Blood, his human Soul, and his godly Divinity. Every time we receive the Eucharist well, his Body, the Church, grows in joy and in love.

We mark this Sunday with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament. The Eucharist is a Person, Jesus Christ. We follow him in procession around our Cathedral Church, and we ask him to bless our lives, our families, our city, and everyone in it. He loves every person. The Blessed Sacrament procession will take place after the 11am Solemn Mass this weekend. It is one of the highlights of our parish's liturgical life, so please do join in the procession if you can.

This Sunday is also a special day of prayer for human life. There will be a **second collection** for the work of various life charities supported by the bishops of our nation. We pray in a special way this year for the elderly, and for proper palliative care, and Bishop John Sherrington, who has oversight of life issues, has written a message for us available at the back and on the website.

Prayer and Adoration for Life - On Wednesday 22 June there will be **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament** for Prayer and Adoration for the intention of the **Sanctity of Life**. Adoration will take place between **6-7 pm**. It will begin with a Rosary for Life followed by silent prayer. All Welcome. Please join in prayerful support.

This Saturday 25th June, a Mass to celebrate the Beatification and Legacy of Pauline Jaricot will take place in the Cathedral at **11.30am** followed by refreshments in the hall and a presentation on *Missio* [Red Box] and the Mill Hill Missionaries.
