This week in the second reading, the author of the letter to the Hebrews talks about Abraham and Sarah, and their faith. In the eucharistic prayer, we join in prayer with “Abraham, our Father in Faith”. The mothers and fathers of the Old Testament are great examples of faith. Many of them are asked to step out into the unknown, into unfamiliar territory, often risking their lives, property, reputations, and comfort. Faith is both a gift and a virtue. It is from God, and we also choose it for ourselves, and live it positively and actively in the circumstances of our own lives. In many and different ways during the course of our own lives, we will also be called to step out into the unknown, always trusting in God’s leadership and his love for us. He always knows what he is doing, and how he will work out his plan for us, even if we sometimes feel a little clueless! We pray to Sarah and Abraham, and all our mothers and fathers in faith, to pray for us, and to help us in our journeys of faith.
