"Ancient Ukraine – Britanii: Common Heritage" is an exhibition showcasing Ukrainian Art and Culture. The exhibition will take place from 14 – 28 January 2023 in **St Joseph's Chapel, Cathedral of St John the Baptist**, Unthank Road Norwich NR2 2PA.

A collection of paintings, historical costumes and artefacts that tell the story of the connection between Kyiv and the British Royal Families will be on display. The exhibition will also explore the richness of the Ukrainian heritage for over 8000 years. The event will be accompanied by a performance by EKA, Ukrainian singer and musician, who plays the ancient national instrument Bandura – one of the symbols of identity of the Ukrainian nation. Kateryna is laureate of international competitions with the distinction of spreading Ukrainian culture abroad. The performance will take place on **14 January at 1pm**.
