Fr Alan and Fr Michael wish you and your families and loved ones a very happy and blessed Easter. Today's Sunday collection is our annual Easter gift to our parish priests, so thank you for your kind generosity.

Congratulations to all who have been initiated into the Christian mystery at the Sacred Paschal Vigil through the sacrament of Baptism. Newly clothed in Christ's glory, please continue to pray for them, as we sing of them in the vespers hymn during Easter.

Pray also for those already baptised who have been **received into the Church** on Easter night, and who also received the sacrament of Confirmation.

Thank you to all those who have worked so hard this week to make our liturgical ceremonies so beautiful; cleaners, sacristy team, musicians and singers, flower arrangers, hospitality and support and ground staff, secretarial staff, servers, readers, volunteers, and all those who have prayed for health, peace and joy.

During the Easter Octave, **only the 10am daily Mass** is celebrated. The Cathedral Church is open from 9am-5pm. Friday **abstinence from meat is also dispensed** this week. In 50 days, we will conclude the festival of Easter with the celebration of Pentecost. The season of Easter is a time of rejoicing and expectation. Eastertide is also longer than Lent because eternal rejoicing is the aim of penance.
