The Solemnity of Corpus Christi is celebrated this Sunday and Bishop Peter will be here to celebrate the 11am Solemn Mass. We celebrate this in honour of the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, and following the Mass there will be a procession around the outside of the Cathedral. This public display of Evangelisation brings the love of Christ from the Church to the street. The procession will return to the Cathedral through the garden for Solemn Pontifical Benediction.

Abstinence this Friday is dispensed because of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Investiture Mass for the Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulchre: This year the cathedral parish is honoured to welcome the Equestrian Order of the Knights and Dames of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem (EOHSJ) to our beautiful cathedral for their investiture ceremony. The Knights and Dames show solidarity with the 'living stones' of the Holy Land. These 'living stones' are the people who maintain and keep the Catholic Faith alive in the Holy Land, often under very difficult and dangerous conditions and without large resources. The funding and support that the Knights and Dames provide is essential in keeping this going for the future of our faith in the Holy Land. They sponsor seminarian students for the priesthood, support parishes and numerous catholic charities as well as helping to maintain the holy sites for future generations.

On Friday evening (16 June) at 7pm there will be a procession and Vigil Service to prepare for the investiture Mass the following day and on Saturday (17 June) at 09:30 the Investiture Mass will be celebrated by The Archbishop of Southwark, Archbishop John Wilson KC*HS (as principal celebrant) with Bishop Peter KCHS and other bishops of the order. For us to host this event as a cathedral parish is indeed a great honour. All are welcome to attend either the Vigil or the Investiture Mass (or both) to celebrate this solemn event with the Knights and Dames. Please note the change of Mass time on Saturday.

Catechists Needed: We have just completed our catechetical year culminating in the celebration of Confirmation at Pentecost and now, throughout June, First Holy Communion too. Now is a good time to consider helping our team of catechists to bring the Gospel and our faith alive for future generations by becoming a catechist yourself.
