It is with a feeling of great sadness that I announce that our Master of Music for the cathedral, Daniel Justin, has decided to move to a new cathedral with a far greater international setting. Daniel has applied for and been successful in being appointed as the Director of Music for St Mary's Cathedral in Sydney, Australia.

Daniel began working for our cathedral and the diocese over eight years ago and has always shown great enthusiasm and excitement for the various projects upon which he has embarked. Daniel has never been shy to roll up his sleeves and get stuck into almost any job that has been asked of him and has done so successfully. During Covid, Daniel ran the estate as General Manager alongside working at providing music for the daily live-streamed Masses. Through his insight, the help of the clergy and generous parishioners, Daniel orchestrated the installation of a multi-camera live-streaming service that inspired many other churches in the diocese to follow suit.

Daniel's professional attitude to music has meant that the cathedral parish has not only been stretched and challenged to build our repertoire up to a standard that is enviable internationally but has also entertained and educated many of us through the sheer variety, technical difficulty and, of course, the beauty of the music he has provided. Daniel has formed and worked with all ages of students in our cathedral and throughout the diocese, especially after he launched the grant-funded Schools' Singing Programme. Our own choristers have benefitted from Daniel's expertise, dedication and kindness. He will be sorely missed by all of us at the cathedral and throughout our diocese.

Daniel will lay down his baton at St John's cathedral for the last time at the end of September as he moves to a truly exciting and incredible new career in Australia. I wish Daniel the very best for his future and that he settles down in Sydney to enhance the musical ministry in that part of the world as well. Sydney is extremely fortunate to have gained a man with the attention to detail, the richness of talent, the *joie de vivre* and the dynamic, positive attitude that is Daniel Justin.
