Today, we celebrate the feast of **The Blessed Virgin Mary of Walsingham** for the first time since it was elevated to a Solemnity in our Diocese by the Vatican in 2021. As such, it replaces the Ordinary Time Sunday. Our Lady of Walsingham, pray for us.

On Friday 29th September, the Bishop will come to celebrate Mass at 12 Noon with a class from every school in the Diocese. <u>Please note</u>: the 10am Mass on Friday <u>will be moved to 9am</u> to accommodate this. THE CAFÉ WILL BE CLOSED ON FRIDAY 29th SEPTEMBER to accommodate the large number of children, and for staff training and maintenance.

Daniel Justin will be leaving us after eight years as our Master of Music on the 5th October, to take up his position as Director of Music at St Mary's Cathedral, Sydney. His last Sunday will be the 1st October, and there will be a Parish celebratory lunch after the 11am Mass, and the bar will be open.
