Joint Bishops' Conference – we welcome the biennial conference of the Anglican and Catholic Bishops Conferences to our Cathedral. Both conferences will be celebrating midday prayer in our Cathedral at 12.15pm on Tuesday 30th January. We wish them every blessing and offer our prayerful support for a successful conference.

Candlemas 2nd February - we celebrate Mass with our brothers and sisters who live the Consecrated life within our Diocese. Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Peter at 11.30am followed by Vespers at approximately 2pm.

There will be **no First Friday Adoration on Friday 2**nd **February** because of the celebrations in the Cathedral that day and for the Feast of the Presentation of Our Lord.
