#### **HYMN NUMBERS FOR THE 9AM MASS**

229/230 (procession), 253, 237, 749

This Sunday is **Palm Sunday**. At the 11am Mass, there will be a solemn procession from the Cathedral Garden, where the **Palm Sunday Gospel** will be proclaimed, and palm branches will be blessed for the procession, Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Blessed palm leaves will be available to take home at all the other Masses.

On **Holy Tuesday at 11.30am**, Bishop Peter will celebrate the **Mass of Chrism** with all the clergy of the diocese, and all parishioners are invited and encouraged to attend. At this Mass, priests renew their priestly promises made at ordination, and the Bishop consecrates the Holy Oils for use during the year: the Oils of the Sick, of Catechumens, and of Sacred Chrism. **Mass is followed by tea, coffee and hot cross buns in the Hall**. All are welcome.

The Easter Triduum [three days] is the annual commemoration of Christ's Passion, Death and Resurrection. It is a single liturgical action spread over those three days: we begin in the cenacle with his Supper, and we end with the women in the Empty Tomb. On these days, the liturgical schedule is different. On each morning, Thursday – Saturday, at 10am, we celebrate Tenebrae [which means darkness], a service of prayerful mourning and anticipation. The principal liturgies and times of confession and Stations [etc] can be seen on the front of the newsletter.

#### **EASTER TRIDUUM COLLECTIONS:**

Maundy Thursday: the collection during the 7pm Mass of the Lord's Supper is taken for the charitable work of the St Vincent de Paul Society for the very poorest and most needy our parish.

Good Friday: the collection after the 3pm Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is taken for the upkeep of the sacred shrines in the Holy Land.

**Easter Weekend**: the collections at Masses of Easter next weekend are our **annual Easter gift to our parish clergy**. This collection forms about a third of our priests' annual income.

Thank you for your generosity towards the **Easter Flowers**: the Flower Guild received £791.11 which will make the Cathedral look as beautiful as possible as we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ.

**Hospital Mass** - Mass is celebrated at 12 noon in the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital Chapel (Centre Block, Level 1) usually on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of every month. Our next Mass will be on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April. Please note - there will be NO MASS on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April (Easter Monday).
