First Friday Adoration will take place on **Friday 5th April**. It will return to the usual times of **after the 10 Mass until 4pm**. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy will be prayed at 3pm. Do come and spend time with the Risen Lord in this Octave of Easter, praying in intercession for Bishop Peter and all our diocesan priests. There is a rota at the back of the church to ensure there is always a presence before Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

Hospital Mass - Mass is celebrated at 12 noon on the 1st and 3rd Monday of every month in the Norfolk and Norwich University Hospital Chapel (Centre Block, Level 1).
