Email scams: It has come to my attention that an email has gone around from me asking for assistance and ultimately money. As a guide: A priest from East Anglia Diocese will never just drop you an unannounced email asking for money for personal use. If we needed money for something church related, we would generally announce it from the ambo, and it would be in the bulletin - in other words it would be known publicly that money *for a project/item* was needed. Check for scams - have a look at the email address, the spelling (normally poor when it is a scam), the language used, the titles used etc. If you are being asked for money in the form of gift cards - it is obviously a scam. If in doubt, check with the office or with the priest directly and verbally. DO not let your kindness be abused.
