Mr Ricketts' final voluntary at the 11am Mass will be the 'Carillon de Westminster' by Louis Vierne, organist of Notre Dame de Paris before his death in 1937. As the name suggests, it is based on the Westminster chimes and was first played by the composer on the organ of Westminster Cathedral in 1924. You are invited to remain in the Cathedral after Mass and listen to the voluntary, followed by the Marian Procession.
