Corpus Christi procession – We welcome all those from around the diocese who were received into the Church at the Easter Vigil this year who have come to celebrate with us at the Cathedral this morning. After Communion, there will be a procession around the Cathedral and through the garden, followed by Benediction.

Friday 7th June is the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from after the **10am Mass until 4pm** when there will be Benediction. **The Divine Mercy Chaplet** will be prayed at **3pm**. Do come and spend time with the Our Blessed Lord on this feast of His Most Sacred Heart. First Friday Adoration is in intercession for all the priests of our diocese and Bishop Peter. Please do sign up on the Rota at the back of the cathedral if you are able to commit to spending half an hour or more before Our Blessed Lord.

Abstinence this Friday is dispensed because of the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Friends of the Cathedral – on 22nd June there will be an 11am Mass, in early celebration of the Nativity of St John the Baptist, followed by a BBQ in the garden hosted by **The Friends of the Cathedral**. All are welcome. Tickets are available from the Narthex £5 for a single ticket / £15 for a family (2 adults 2 children).

Launch of the Friends of St Francis - Families and individuals interested in **Saint Francis** are welcome to join secular Franciscans on Sunday 23rd June from 12.30pm – 2.00pm at St. John's Cathedral for a bring your own family picnic. There will be some children's activities. For anyone who wants to join us, we will then walk to Mother Julian's Shrine, returning to St. John's for Vespers and Mass. From Advent 2024, we will be using an updated translation of the Bible for our readings at Mass, as approved by Rome and our bishops. These changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages, to reflect current biblical scholarship and to provide a text for use in a liturgical setting that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive.

The Lectionaries are changed very infrequently but do come at quite a cost! The 4 volumes necessary to cover the whole liturgical year will cost £173.75 each (£695 in total) The Book of the Gospels for use at St John's Cathedral will cost £395. If any person, family, or group would be willing to contribute towards these costs please contact Cathy in the office, one of the clergy or the sacristans. Should you wish to donate to this cause then please mark your envelope clearly with the word 'Lectionary'. People's Missals will be available in the Narthex shop towards the end of the year once they have been printed. Thank you, as always, for your generosity.
